ATTORNEY GENERAL HITS THE TARGET

January 19, 2018-Tamuning, Guam-“Guam residents can now shop online at TARGET®,” stated General Barrett-Anderson.

Attorney General Elizabeth Barrett-Anderson has been urging Target to open its online shipping services to residents of Guam for the past two years. Up until two days ago, Target has rebuffed the Attorney General’s efforts.

In a recent Wall Street Journal article entitled “The Last Place on Earth Where Everyone Still Loves Kmart” touting the successes of Kmart on Guam, the WSJ made an inquiry with Target as to why it did not ship to Guam when it shipped to Mongolia and Kiribati.

As a result of the WSJ inquiry, Target has opened its online shipping to Guam. Attorney Barrett-Anderson wrote to the WSJ reporter and thanked her for the final push that got Target to be responsive to Guam consumers.

Today General Barrett-Anderson conducted a test purchase. Target does not ship to Post Office Box addresses, but will ship to physical address locations on Guam. The Attorney General will continue to work with Target to resolve the post office box restrictions.
